Construction Activity Update for Schulich Building

The drill rig currently at grout shaft #3 will be disassembled and removed either Saturday or Sunday of this weekend, as the drilling of the grout shafts have been completed. During the early morning hours of Monday March 12th, a similar drill rig will be moved onto site, adjacent to the Schulich building and will begin the drilling operations for the station box and the utility diversion.

Drilling with the rig will result in regular and intermittent noise stemming from the debris being shaken off the auger as needed. The drill rig will be in close proximity to the building, with some work as close as 1.5 meters from the building.

This stage of work and other less intrusive activities are anticipated to continue for the next few months. Efforts are being made to minimize the impact to the community and to work in a safe manner.
