CONSTRUCTION UPDATE #34

Construction Activities West of James Gillies Street Beside the Schulich School of Business June 17 – June 25, 2013

Starting on June 17, 2013, the fenced construction area west of James Gillies Street and east of the Schulich School of Business will have increased construction activity. Construction activities include demolition of two metres of piles and backfilling the compensation grouting shaft. This work is expected to last until June 25, 2013. The completion date for this work is weather permitting.

The contractor will be working east of Schulich School of Business near the entrance of the colonnade. Pedestrians should follow the walkway signs posted in this area and at the Schulich colonnade.

Removal Timeline

The demolition of the piles will be done in stages. Work will be done within the perimeter fencing and in accordance with all municipal bylaws. All activities will be fully monitored and supervised. Demolition work is expected to last five days within the construction duration mentioned above.

Noise and vibration monitors have previously been installed in key locations on and near the construction site to record noise and vibration levels. During the demolition and removal activities noise and vibration may be experienced as a result of this typical construction work.

Work Hours

Construction hours are 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday.
